He was a cast member and one of the finalists of Total Drama Action as a member of Screaming Gaffers. He originally left the Total Drama World Tour but was forced to return as soon as he was found in I See London... and was placed in Chris' team really really hot. He was spotted with original contestants on a yacht in the first episode of Total Drama: Revenge of the Island, and he made a cameo appearance in Grand Chef Auto. He was a member of Total Drama All-Stars, and was originally a member of the Villain Vultures, but was later switched to Heroic Hamsters in Saving Private Lichball. Duncan's personality is the definition of a bad boy, being a cunning, cool juvenile delinquent who comes from a long line of cops and police women: his dad, mom, uncle, aunt, grandmother and cousins are all cops. He knows many tactics from his time spent in juvenile detention centers. It can cut an image of a skull into a tree trunk and lift a large amount of weight (like Owen, which is more than three times its size). He has a brooding, nasty, sarcastic and flirtatious personality, flirting with Heather, despite his seeming dislike of her and mocking Kourtney whenever she approaches him. He also gives Courtney the name of the pet princess to tease her. Duncan likes to break the rules to better satisfy himself, but sometimes the consequences are worse than he intended. Duncan also likes to make fun of other contestants and pull a few pranks on them, with Harold being his main victim (later stepping him up because of a certain move Harold made at Total Drama Island). He considers himself straight to people, rarely pretending to be someone he is not. As a result, it has been shown that he will either get along with or make fierce enemies with his fellow competitors, although this is more than often the latter. Despite his average attitude and demeanor, Duncan is actually a good person at heart, although he never admits it to anyone else. Such moments of displaying this side of it include finding a new rabbit for his DJ friend after Jeff loses first, carving him and Courtney's initials on a tree, and defending Lindsay after she betrayed Heather. Some time with Harold also makes him consider ending his feud with him after so long although it was not successful. As a way to express his feelings for the girl he loves, Duncan uses his knife to cut her name or face or protect her during problems. In Total Drama All-Stars, being on heroic hamsters begins to bring out his better hand (which infuriates him as it destroys his bad boy image), but soon proves that he's a bad boy again by blowing up Chris Cottage. The whole drama of Duncan Island is not happy to be in camp Wawanakwa. Duncan appears to be joining Total Drama to avoid going back to prison. He is the seventh person to arrive on the island in not-so-happy Holidaymakers - Part 1, where he will quickly make enemies with Heather, Noah and Harold. He is surprised to see that Camp Wawanakwa is not a five-star resort, as he said on the app. He told Chris that he didn't like surprises, and Chris told him that Duncan's parole officer could always take him back to law enforcement. He is placed on Bass-Killer, where his vile, aggressive behavior makes many fear him. He finds pleasure in gathering on Harold and making his life miserable by pranking him on several occasions in Total Drama Island and Total Drama Action. Its reputation is also well known to screaming gophers, and as a result most holidaymakers keep a distance from him. Despite this, he manages to become good friends with DJ and Jeff, with whom he often hangs out. While Duncan himself is a strong competitor, he is not above cheating to give himself an advantage, though he is always caught in the act of Chris, who often brings up his parole officer to keep Duncan in check. Duncan finds a new rabbit for a DJ. From the first call, Duncan has been skeptical of Courtney's so-called leadership qualities. Duncan is actually one of the first to offer a vote from Courtney because of her poor performance in issues such as the inability to dive off a cliff. In addition, Kourtney doesn't like Duncan, often mocking him for his punk appearance and his reputation as a criminal. Despite this initial tension, they show that they have feelings for each other. Although unlike Courtney, Duncan does not deny it and often flirts with Courtney, calling her household names. As the season progresses, Courtney continues to reject him and even kicking him in the groin at one point. In if you can't take the heat ... Duncan, along with DJ and Jeff, prank Harold after he continues to leave his dirty clothes in the booth, eventually leads Harold to promise never to leave his clothes on the floor again. In Who Can You Trust?, Courtney discover that Duncan has found a new rabbit for DJ, after Jeff loses first. When she asks him about it, Duncan pretends that he doesn't know what she means before finally confessing. Realizing that he is better than her allows further. Courtney begins to see Duncan in a new light and promises to keep it a secret, much to Duncan's annoyance. Duncan and Courtney share their first kiss. In Basic Straining, Duncan most of his time prank Harold or provoking chef Hatchet instead of focusing on the challenge at hand. Courtney tries to make sure he doesn't get problems, though Duncan teases her that she is doing it because she loves it, to her disappointment. Eventually, the chef loses patience with Duncan and sends him to the Boathouse. Kourtney pays him a visit and after a brief conversation about each other's behavior, Duncan convinces Courtney to break some rules and join him in stealing food from the chef. They return to the cabins and share stolen food with other holidaymakers. After another conversation with Duncan Courtney pulls Duncan and kisses him, starting their relationship. After their team loses, Duncan is shocked when he learns that Courtney is out. Unbeknownst to Duncan, Harold faked his voice to eliminate Courtney to return to him for bullying him. As boat losers sail off, Duncan has a tearful farewell to Courtney and gives her a farewell gift, a wooden skull that he cut out. He's happy when Courtney said it was weird, but that she would cherish them. Soon the contestants are divided into boys and girls. Duncan and his group immediately get along with the remaining boys from Gophers, Trent and Owen. Despite their bond, the boys immediately far away themselves at No Pain, No Game after Chris announced the merger. However, after Trent is eliminated in the search and not destroyed, Duncan realizes that the girls outnumbered the boys and the rallies of the remaining boys in hiding and being sneaky to form the union of the first guys. Although it took some intimidation to convince Owen, the other boys eventually agreed to vote with him from one of the girls. After the challenge is over, Duncan convinces them to vote from Bridget, seeing her athletic skills a threat to which everyone (except Jeff) agrees. That night, although Bridget was voted, Jeff admits he didn't vote for her, sparking Duncan's ire. In That's Off the Chain!, Duncan continues to lead an alliance of guys and is visibly angry that Owen and the DJ are talking to Lindsay. While the other girl is eliminated, Duncan defends Lindsay when she betrayed Heather, saying what Heather did to her was cold compared to everything he did. Duncan and Gwen talk about their favorite scene from Blood Bath 2: Summer Camp Reign of Terror. In Hook, Line, and Screamer, Duncan ties with Gwen as they discover a common interest in horror movies, even having the same favorite movie. When it is reported that the escaped killer is at large, Duncan is the only person to take Gwen's advice seriously while others leave on their own and end up being captured. Eventually, Duncan hears someone calling his name, and leaves the camp to find the killer standing in the dock of Shame. Duncan quickly disarms the killer, only to find out that it was really a masked chef and that the real killer is in the cabin with Gwen. Duncan high fives Gwen when she defeats the real killer. In Wawanakwa Gone Wild!, decided to form an alliance Heather and agrees to help her catch her pet. This union was only short-lived however as after two of them exclude Izzy, their partnership is not mentioned again. Duncan reveals his lechon secret in court over the Tri-Armed Triathlon. Duncan is a partner of Leshon, with whom he does not get along. Two of them often argue throughout the episode, often physically, about who gets to do the necessary task. In the first call, they compete in an armwrestling match to see who should be filing, in which Duncan wins by deception. Later, they argue about who should sit in front of the canoe and who should carry the other. Eventually, the argument begins to subside when Leshon declares that Duncan is actually a good man and will not come to his threat. Duncan pretends he had no idea what she was saying while Leshona was bringing up the incident about the rabbit DJ, revealing what Courtney told her about it. Duncan admitted that when he was younger, his beloved dog ran away, and he didn't want the DJ to feel the same way. They put up with each other and continue with the task. At the end of the episode, Duncan decided to vote for Jeff for failing to vote for Bridget a few episodes ago. Duncan and Duncan farewell after he's eliminated in We're There Yet? At Camp Castaways, Duncan is caught in a fight between Heather and Gwen. When holidaymakers drifted on a desert island, Duncan initially declares that he is happy to be alone with two beautiful girls, but dismisses it as their arguments get on their nerves. After the hunt, Duncan tries to leave the island with Gwen, but they run out on the opposite side of the island and end up back at the tree house where Heather is on, with the newly arrived Owen joining them. After a heartfelt conversation with each other at Owen's suggestion, the last four return to camp after seeing smoke from Chris and the camping chef. Duncan paired up with Owen in Are We There Yet?. Although Duncan often scolds Owen, they get along easily and are able to outsmart girls several times. Ultimately, because of Owen's appetite, the two of them lose the challenge and Duncan is eliminated, although he is not disappointed. While Heather mocks him for not allied with her, and Owen accidentally burps on his face while trying to say goodbye to him, he shares a punch with Gwen, who sees him as a respected player. Duncan returns to the final, being one of Owen's original supporters, before announcing the party he is going to pass if he wins. At one point, he and Courtney end up arguing about the finalist's situation, but the two of them eventually make out. Duncan intimidates an alligator in Total Drama, Drama, Drama, Drama Island. In a special, he and Courtney teamed up to find a deal with a million. After Duncan manages to fight the alligator that ate the case, he travels to the rock and sprains his ankle. Despite the fact that he for help, Kourtney throws it with the fact of it with her. When Noah comes and mocks him, Duncan rips off Noah's pants in revenge. After he was able to walk again, Duncan manages to return to the camp, but he is attacked by moose. However, he protects it with the moose's head from the main lodge. Above, Kourtney cheers for him, but Duncan is still bitter about her betrayal and threatens her by saying he is following her. Duncan ended up riding the moose on his back and ended up thrown into the lake with thirteen other contestants. As the case was eaten by a shark, Duncan is one of those eligible for Total Drama Action, despite Duncan's protest of involvement in another season. Duncan's total dramatic action friendship with Gwen made Courtney and Trent jealous. Duncan returns to the new season, continuing his role as the antihero of the series. From the beginning, he and Gwen became close friends because they both had a lot of interests. It made Gwen's boyfriend, Trent, jealous, seeing how these two have so much in common, while he couldn't even start a topic with her. His anger is further escalated, especially when Gwen chose Duncan as the first member of her team. Unaware of his anger, Duncan begins to pull the antics on Trent, angering him even more. Trent's jealousy made him become the obsessed number nine, and Duncan only made things worse by informing Gwen of a possible connection between the number and their relationship. This leads to a series of events in which both the break-up of Trent and Gwen and their subsequent exceptions. Duncan is one of the few people (another being a DJ) who still defends Gwen after she is caught challenging for another team. He even tries to take her place in Lane-O-sine, but admits he was only joking. Before she leaves the show, Gwen wishes Duncan good luck. Duncan continues to choose Harold. With Gwen's departure, Duncan unofficially replaces her as captain of the Screaming Gaffers. He won a lot of challenges for his team, earning him respect from his teammates. However, his hatred of Harold has not changed. It turned out that Duncan learned of Harold's actions last season that led Courtney to be eliminated, leading to Duncan stepping up his abuse of him. In addition to this, Duncan is also sometimes mocked for Harold's feelings for Leshon. Meanwhile, Leshon tries to get Duncan and Harold into an alliance with her to protect themselves from Heather. She first tried one Flu Over cuckoos, but at the mention of working with Harold, Duncan just laughs at her and rejects her suggestion. After winning the challenge, Leshona began to cry, saying she was worried about the safety of her friends throughout the episode. Seeing this, Duncan nominates to give the award to Leshon, and everyone else agrees with him. Two episodes later, however, Gaffers discovers that Leshona pretended to cry to pretend reward everyone for themselves, the wrath of Duncan. With the discovery of her scam, Duncan gives Leshon a cold shoulder in The Full Metal drama and tells Harold and Heather to do the same. For a military challenge, Duncan once again takes responsibility for his team and questions the usefulness of Harold. He shows a confession that he always dreams of joining the army. Duncan easily wins the second challenge, creating a giant skull with explosives and successfully defends his team when the opposing team starts the attack. With the situation becoming a toaster, Duncan admits to Harold he actually has a small degree of respect for him in order for them to retreat. Their joint efforts allow them to defeat the Grips again, gaining immunity for their team and taking a peak inside the Chest Mind Blowing Secrets, which contains nothing inside, to their horror. Duncan is shocked to see Courtney return to Ocean's Eight - or Nine. Duncan and the rest of the team continue to ignore Leshon in ocean's Eight - or Nine - and don't even worry she's missing. As his team tries to open up the vault, Duncan is annoyed by seeing how incompetent Harold and Heather are and even more annoying that they have forgotten that he is an experienced criminal. Seeing that the other team was leading, Duncan told them to abandon Leshon and improvise the tools needed to call using Harold's stuff. When their team is about to rob a bank, teller shows himself to be Courtney. The sight of her made Duncan faint. It turns out that Courtney will return to the competition and will be placed on Killer Grips. In the second part of the challenge, Duncan easily collected his team's go-kart and brought them to victory, reaching the finish line in front of another team despite their cards ran out of gas in the last minute. On their return, Duncan and Courtney put their relationship aside and became mortal enemies. With Courtney's return, Duncan knows his team needs to work harder to win. While Duncan still harbors feelings for her, he hated the fact that Courtney would stand so low in using dirty tactics to make sure she wins the season. Kourtney, on the other hand, is angry with Duncan for being close to Gwen, believing he's cheating on her. They pair up against each other in one million bucks, B.C. and million dollar babies and Courtney wins on both occasions as Duncan goes out of his way not to have his relationship with Courtney eventually, as Trent and Gwen. Meanwhile, he discovered that Leshon was badmouthing contestants during her trip to the spa, calling Duncan blind whenever Courtney is around him, further angering Duncan. However, listening to her song of apology, Duncan and Harold lets her stay a little longer and voted for Heather instead. Duncan and Justin are fighting for Courtney's love in The Pride of the Princess. After reaching a merger, Duncan and Harold finally agree with Leshon forming an alliance. However, they followed her back in the next episode, forming a new alliance of guys with Justin. They agree to vote for Leshon that night, as their biggest threat is invincibility. Harold initially refuses, but after some convincing from Courtney (whom Duncan is convinced), he agrees. Meanwhile, Courtney's enemies (including Leshon) also took aim at him, believing that removing Duncan would make Courtney lose his advantage. In the end, however, Duncan gets the last gilded Chris and Leshon eliminated. The Union of Guys continues in Princess Pride, but tensions rise between Duncan and Justin throughout the episode. During the first call, Duncan pranks Justin, fooling him into walking in the wrong direction while Justin is blindfolded. Later, Justin noticed Duncan cheating, but Chris ignores him. Later, Justin is attracted to Courtney, which leads him to a fight with jealous Duncan for the love of Courtney. Their conflict, along with Justin's elimination later in this episode, marks the end of the guys' alliance. Duncan smashes his guitar in Rock n' Rule. In Get a Clue, Duncan manages to steal the DNA of one Harold as he tries to steal it using a complex trap. Throughout the episode, Duncan easily deceived Courtney several times. The first time she treats him to dinner and massage, which is actually for her to steal a strand of hair from him (although she has already taken one from Lindsay), and everyone (except Courtney) handcuffs him. In the end, Lindsay wins the challenge and finds evidence that Duncan is innocent. To make her mistake, she invited him to the movies. Because of their differences, the two of them find their date awkward, but it was fun to make Courtney jealous. In Rock n' Rule, Duncan wins the first challenge by playing guitar carelessly and then smashes it into true rock 'n' roll band fashion. He also performs well in the second challenge, although he loses points for the damage he caused. After all, Courtney wins invincibility and Duncan is a target for other contestants again. However, by sheer luck, Duncan is spared as Lindsay accidentally casts a decisive vote for herself and is eliminated. Duncan and Harold ended their short-lived friendship. In Crouching Courtney, Hidden Owen, Duncan trains Harold in preparation for the first call. Through his training, Duncan is able to bring out the inner strength of Harold and together, they win the first challenge and move on to the next. During this period, two of them begin to make amends, as neither of them wants to sabotage the other and even agrees to share the reward together. Just as things between them get better, Owen, by convincing Harold to hit Duncan that he does so after Duncan makes fun of Leshon, ending their short-lived friendship. This action gives Harold enough confidence to give Duncan a taste of his own medicine by putting stones on his bed in 2008: Owen Space. After Harold accidentally killed Duncan Tarantula's beloved pet, Scruffy, Duncan votes for him. Before leaving Harold parts Duncan, to whom Duncan admits he was kinda was that coming. Duncan and Beth are announced as the final two of Total Drama Action. In Top Dog, Duncan and Courtney spend the night together before discussing their relationship and Courtney decides to give him a chance, provided he reads and memorizes a thirty-two-page long letter that highlights all the mistakes Duncan needs to correct. This caused Duncan to be sleepy for most of the problem. In the forest, Duncan's chameleon disappears and he eventually falls into the pit. Duncan slowly begins to go crazy and to satisfy his hunger, he eats a letter Courtney give him. Two days later, Duncan returns to the movie, dressed as a wild man and armed with a primitive weapon. It wasn't until Courtney kissed him that he would return to his normal self. Owen tells him that his chameleon has been with him all this time, mingling with the color of Duncan's Iroguiots. Tired of Courtney's power rules and control over him, Duncan voted for her that night. Angry betrayal, Courtney breaks up with him. Moments later, Owen fired Chris, leaving Duncan and Beth the only contestants remaining in the season. Courtney and Duncan reunite after the latter wins Total Drama Action. During the finale, Duncan rejects the idea of Beth working together for a challenge as he wanted to claim victory for his own. He manages to get a start during the first call, but since he is unable to answer any of the questions the chef asked correctly, he is obliged to compete for all the challenges of the season again. Beth ended up catching up with him on the last question, as she knew a lot about her fellow contestants. To Duncan's delight, the last question about Courtney, about which he allegedly knows a lot. Unfortunately, the question was what he did not know: What color does Courtney think? As both finalists failed to answer the last question correctly, they had to compete for the earthquake simulator challenge again. Duncan and Beth eventually help each other to make it to the finish line, resulting in a draw. In order to determine the winner, Harold assumes that the two of them compete in the acrobat challenge, but this too end up in a tie. As soon as Chris returns, he has ruled out contestants from voting for the winner by asking them questions. No matter which end happens, Duncan ends up back with Courtney. After the second time, Duncan and Courtney reunite. This revealed in Celebrity Hunting Total Action Drama Reunion Special. Despite the couple pair Duncan and Courtney broke up again, and Duncan filed a lawsuit against Courtney over custody of their pet raccoon, Brittany (a parody of a broken couple fighting for custody of their child). Meanwhile, rumors begin to spread that Gwen begins to fall in love with Duncan, putting the situation in a tense position. Duncan joins his fellow contestants in New York to stop the Dirtbags, but along the way, he and Kourtney eventually do, sending their bus off a cliff. He stays on the bus with several others while Jeff finds help. In the end, he and those who stayed are saved by Chris, who announces that they qualified for the third season, the Total Drama World Tour. Total World Tour drama Duncan angrily tells Chris off and leaves the show. Duncan begins the third season in a very good place with his newly reunited girlfriend Courtney and his close friend Gwen. Like Gwen, Duncan strongly opposes the idea that contestants should sing every episode. In Egypt, Duncan and two girls will work together during the first call, but between the girls everything becomes tense, which is very annoying. As soon as his team get to the top of the pyramid, the two girls continue to argue and Chris yells at them to go down as it's time for another musical number. Duncan finally snaps and runs down the pyramid, dragging Courtney and Gwen along with him and yelling at Chris that he's leaving, shocking Gwen and Courtney. Duncan officially goes through Drop of Shame in the next episode after Ezekiel picked it up. The exclusive clip shows that after having trouble activating his parachute, Duncan hangs from a tree and is surrounded by scarabs. One of Duncan's possible observations after his elimination. After his departure, and until the end of the first half of the season, Duncan will be mysteriously spotted around the world in places like Scotland, Sweden, Texas and Italy. His disappearance and observations were included in a segment of Aftermath called Total Dramatic Fugitives. Blaley also mentioned that Chris was looking for him, even sending giant dramatic machines everywhere. His absence was also brought up by Gwen and Courtney's Newf Kids on the Rock, as casually shows how much they miss him in the confessional (although the former mistaken it to be her boyfriend last season, not Trent). While the Amazon team are on their way to Newfoundland, the two girls believe they saw him standing on top of a mountain, but in turns out to be a rock formation that resembles it. Eventually, Duncan ended up in London to perform with his band, which coincides with the last country the contestants visit. He was captured by the two girls he was closest to too when they hit their heads at a club in Whitechapel and returned to the plane. Upon discovering where he is, Duncan quickly looks for a way out, but Chris stops him, revealing that the whole task was to drag Duncan back and force him to fulfill his contract (to his chagrin). Soon he fits into Chris's team really really hot. He soon scolded Courtney for giving up on her before the two hugged her, but for now, he's completely over Courtney, and has grown romantic feelings for Gwen. While Gwen uses confessional, Duncan accidentally burst in and after a brief banter, the two end up kissing, with Tyler as the sole witness. Duncan and Gwen share their second kiss and become the official couple in the EX-Files. In Greek plays, Duncan threatens Tyler not to disclose about the kiss he had with Gwen. Unfortunately, Tyler was pressured by Alejandro to reveal his secret during the tiebreak. Upon learning that he had lost another chance to be with Gwen again, Cody angrily punches Duncan, starting a conflict between them. With a goal on his back, Duncan was supposed to be eliminated that night, but Chris wanted to prolong the drama and eliminates the intern instead. After a messy breakup with Kourtney, he and Gwen officially start a relationship after they shared their second kiss in EX-Files. Unfortunately, their time together was short as Gwen is eliminated in the next episode as a result of Cody and Duncan fighting. Duncan, however, won't forget about her, and can be seen carving an image of her face on the side on one of Sweden's first-class loungers. Miraculously, despite all the wrong actions he has done, he manages to get away with most of his actions until he got involved with Alejandro, which soon leads to his downfall. Alejandro and Duncan race along the Great Wall of China. That's around this time when he started getting involved with Alejandro, how to get involved with two women for the season. They both came up with a plan to tinker with the Amazon team, pretending to fight for Courtney, and Alejandro flirting with Courtney, so Heather will be jealous, and the team will completely self-destruct. Duncan, however, admits that he does not trust Alejandro in Sweden Sour and Owen's advice to do the same, using Noah's absence. Once the teams are combined, he thinks that Gwen is going to come back (missing it dearly), only to be told that someone else will be coming back.
